### **PUBLIC RELATIONS:**

The Public Relations subcommittee meeting was held this morning at Beyond Bread, Speedway & Wilmot, at 11:00 a.m. The meeting was attended by Gary M., Chairperson, Steve S., Judy C., Danny W., Dean W., and Kathleen L. The meeting was opened with the Serenity Prayer and the purpose and vision statements of the Public Relations subcommittee were read.

Old Business: The last PR event was the Homeless Connect on Friday, September 30, 2016. The event was well attended. Thank you Danny W. for your service.

There are currently nine bus shelters in Tucson and one in Nogales. The committee is discussing the possibility of two interior posters for the bus. The cost would be \$500 annually (or \$20/poster/month) and the buses would run randomly throughout Tucson. The committee also discussed the possibility of having a logo contest to decide on the design for the interior posters.

Mari B is the literature chairperson for H&I. Kathleen L. suggested creating a webpage for PR within the website natucson.org. The committee discussed various ideas. The discussion was tabled for further review.

The committee is currently looking for members who meet the current clean time requirement to join the SEAZNA-PR subcommittee.
