H&I continues to carry the message into our facilities throughout the Tucson area.

For this reporting period, we reached approximately 1,389 addicts through our H&I panels.

Facility openings:

Pima County Jail – Women's: 1st week 10am tues

Casa de Vida: 5th week – Sat 10am

El Dorado: 2nd and 5th week - Sat 630pm

Palo Verde: 4th week - Friday 530pm

VA: All weeks available, plus a panel opportunity 6pm Sat. Covid vaccine, TB test, and background required for badge. VA orientation and paperwork is less of a hassle than it sounds like.

We are also looking into the possibility of putting together an Ad Hoc Committee for guideline review.

Panel reminder: Emails regarding all panels will now be coming from our new H&I Secretary, so please be aware of the change.

H&I T-Shirt Fundraiser:
